III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.
Staff members, P.D. and D.D. did not have the requirement during my onsite.	
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(5) Within 90 days of being hired, or the first day as an unsupervised volunteer, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall complete the following trainings, which may count toward annual professional development hours and are available at MiRegistry: (a) Administration of medication. (b) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions. (c) Building and physical premises safety. (d) Emergency preparedness and response planning. (e) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants. (f) Precautions in transporting children, if applicable. (g) Child development.
Six of the staff members working in 2021 did not complete the required 2021 refresher.	
R 400.8137	Diapering; toileting.
	(1) Except as provided in subrule (2) of this rule, diapering must occur in a designated diapering area that complies with all of the following: (c) Has non-absorbent, smooth, easily cleanable surfaces in good repair.
The diaper pad in the restroom used by the toddlers was not in good repair. The pad had multiple rips.	
R 400.8152	Medication; administrative procedures.
	(3) All medication must be in its original container, stored according to instructions, and clearly labeled for a named child, including all nonprescription topical medications described in subrule (8) of this rule.

Two children (J.G. and C.M.) had prescription hydrocortisone ointment on file without the original box with the pharmacy label.	
R 400.8152	Medication; administrative procedures.
	(6) A child care staff member shall give or apply any prescription or nonprescription medication according to the directions on the original container, unless otherwise authorized by a written order of the child's physician.
An over-the-counter medication by Zarbee's had a serving suggestion for children age 12 to adult was given to a 1 year old child [REDACTED]. The medication was given while in care on two recent occasions, 01/30/23 and 03/06/23. Ms. McKinney who signed the medication form for these two occasions shared she was aware of the age suggestions and did not read the bottle prior to giving the medication.	

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/10/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
