The purpose of the Interim inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care Center.

During the Interim inspection, licensing consultant Thomasa Bond found 12 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 3/8/2024.

Due to the health and safety professional development training violation(s), all of the facility's child care staff members must complete the required training by 3/20/2024.

Due to the infant safe sleep violation(s), all of the facility's infant child care staff members must take training on infant safe sleep. This must be included in the facility's corrective action plan and completed by 3/22/2024. In addition, a follow up inspection may be made to check compliance with the infant safe sleep rules.


