**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

	(6) The licensee or licensee designee shall maintain accurate records detailing daily arrival and departure times for each child care staff member, child care aide, and volunteer.
Staff did not maintain accurate daily attendance with arrival and departure times.	
<b>R 400.8122</b>	<b>Lead caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities.</b>
	(9) Verification of the education, credentials, and experience of each lead caregiver shall be kept on file at the center or at MiRegistry.
Verification of hours of education needed for one lead caregiver.

	(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

<p>The staff did not wash their hands after cleaning the tables.</p>	
<b>R 400.8134</b>	<b>Hand washing.</b>
	<p>(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(d) When soiled.</li> </ul>

Children's hands were not washed after lunch, before eating, and after cleaning their nose.

	(1) At the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. The center shall keep it on file and accessible in the center.

<b>R 400.8325</b>	<b>Sanitization.</b>
	(5) If the manual washing method is used, as referenced in subrule (4)(c) and (d) of this rule, all of the following must be done: (e) Air dry.
The staff did not allow the sanitizing solution to air dry.	

<b>R 400.8340</b>	<b>Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.</b>
	(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.
The children's lunches from home were not labeled or dated.	
<b>R 400.8345</b>	<b>Water supply; plumbing.</b>
	(4) All plumbing fixtures and water and waste pipes must be properly installed and maintained in good working condition.
The sink in the boy's bathroom drips and the 4 <sup>th</sup> toilet has a chipped base.	
<b>R 400.8380</b>	<b>Maintenance of premises.</b>
	(1) The premises must be maintained in a clean and safe condition and must not pose a threat to health or safety.
The black edging outside on the playground has raised bolts.	
<b>R 400.8380</b>	<b>Maintenance of premises.</b>
	(5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.
The wooden bench outside on the playground has deteriorating paint.	
<b>REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED</b> <b>LSR dated 05/10/2019</b> <b>CAP dated 05/08/2019</b>	

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
