R 400.8143 Children's records.	Center attendance was not accurately maintained. Attendance records did not include children's last names.	The licensee will ensure that last names are included on all attendance records.	01/19/2022


R 400.8320 Food preparation.	Bare hands were used to serve ready to eat foods. A preschool staff member did not wear gloves while serving grapes at lunch time.	The licensee will ensure that gloves are worn while serving food.	01/19/2022
