**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8112 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.**

**(2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:**

**(e) Within the department's child care background check system, accurately complete and maintain the connection, disconnection, or withdrawn status of each individual associated with the license.**

The applicant did not accurately complete the connection status of each individual associated with the license. Child Care Staff Member Tammy Domke was not connected to the child license.

**R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.**

**(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.**

Child care staff members were not trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment prior to working with children. Child Care Staff Member Tammy Domke did not have these trainings on file.

#### **IV. RECOMMENDATION**

Upon receipt of an acceptable CAP, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care facility.
