

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8134 Hand washing.

(2) All staff and volunteers shall wash their hands at all of the following times:

(c) Before preparing and serving food and feeding children.

I observed a child care staff member (CCSM) feed an infant without washing her hands prior to.

R 400.8134 Hand washing.

(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:

(b) After toileting or diapering.

A CCSM changed three (toddler) diapers without ensuring that each of the children washed their hands afterwards.

R 400.8140 Discipline.

(2) All of the following means of punishment are prohibited:

(i) Time out must not be used for children under 3 years of age.

I observed a time out method being used in the 2 ½ year classroom. The CCSM confirmed this was a redirective method used at which time children are removed from the group and asked to sit at a table for approximately 1 to 4 minutes.

R 400.8350 Toilets; hand washing sinks.

(5) Hand washing sinks must have warm running water not to exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

The handwashing sink in the infant room exceeded 120 degrees Fahrenheit. The water temperature tested at 127 degrees Fahrenheit.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on the following:

-Add tweezers to bus first aid kit R400.1600(3)(kk)


-Updated flares were added to the bus during onsite (ensure appropriate flares are on bus at all times)

-Milk furnished in multi-day supply must be returned to parent or discarded 7 days after opening (5 cartons of milk were onsite past the 7 days of opening date).

-Add handwashing sign to bathroom sink (in Pre-K classroom)

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular status license.
