
Violation cited	Noncompliance observed	Plan to correct	Date to be completed
R400.8380(1)	The entry door used by the preschool families was not in good repair. At the time of this incident the safety latch that keeps the motion of the door from slamming was broken. As a result, Child A was injured.	We put in a request for the door to be repaired. Once that was put in, we were waiting on the part to come in. The part came in on 10/24/2022 and was installed after arrival of students, shortly after this incident occurred. I spoke to the facility team and superintendent about the seriousness of getting repairs done in a timely manner. They assured me that it was a parts issue, so next time we will need to completely block off a broken door.	Put in request for repairs on 06/24/2022, 08/03/2022. Door was repaired on 10/24/2022. Effective immediately.

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
