### Findings of the Inspection

The purpose of the Interim Inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care centers.

During the Interim Inspection, licensing consultant, Alicia Wiggins, found 3 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 06/05/2024.

During the on-site inspection, I reviewed children's records and staff members' files. I observed children in care engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including dancing, playing board games, coloring, and outdoor play. I also observed toileting, hand washing, and meal service. The caregivers' interactions with the children were positive and nurturing. They were attentive to the children's needs.
