R 400.8131(6)	Child care staff members did not take 16 hours annual professional development training.	On 05/17/2024 the licensee designee will inform staff that they need to take 16 hours of annual training. She will monitor staff to ensure training is completed.	05/17/2024
R 400.8161(8)	Staff were not trained on emergency procedures 2 times a year.	The licensee designee will ensure that staff are trained on emergency procedures. She will ensure that the training is documented.	05/17/2024
R 400.8143(6)(c)	A physical evaluation was not on file within 30 days of initial attendance. One child did not have a physical on file. The child started care in September 2024.	The licensee designee will reach out to the parent and request a physical evaluation. She will review files to ensure compliance is met for all children.	05/15/2024


R 400.8125(1)	Appropriate care and supervision was not provided in the hallway and bathroom. Children were sent to the restroom independently. The bathroom is located down the hallway and around the corner.	Staff will provide appropriate care and supervision. Staff will take children to the bathroom in groups to ensure supervision is always provided.	05/15/2024
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
