Findings of the Inspection

The purpose of the Interim Inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care Center.

During the on-site inspection, I observed children in care engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including playing with Legos, playing board games, coloring, and outdoor play. I also observed toileting, hand washing, meal service, and nap time. The child care staff members'

interactions with the children were positive and nurturing. They were engaged with the children while being attentive to their needs.

During the Interim Inspection, licensing consultant Alicia Wiggins found 5 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 07/24/2024.

Due to the health and safety professional development training violations, all of the facility's child care staff members must complete the required training by 05/24/2024. This must be included in the facility's corrective action plan.
