Dear Ms. Kline:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 10/18/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

**R 400.8134 Hand washing.**

- (3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:
  - (b) After toileting or diapering.

The staff member in Room 14 did not ensure that the children washed hands after diapering.

**R 400.8137 Diapering; toileting.**

- (1) Except as provided in subrule (2) of this rule, diapering must occur in a designated diapering area that complies with all of the following:
  - (b) Is within close proximity to a sink that is used exclusively for hand washing.

Both the mobile one's classrooms used the same sink for diapering and food services.

**R 400.8340**

**Food services and nutrition; provided by parents.**

(7) Milk and other beverages furnished in a multi-day supply must be labeled with the child's first and last name and the date of opening and be returned to the parent or discarded 7 days after opening.

The half-gallon of milk in the young preschool room was not labeled with the child's first name, last name or date opened.

**R 400.8530**

**Hazard Areas.**

(9) The center shall not store flammable materials, including fuels, pressurized cans, cleaning fluids and supplies, polishes, and matches, in heat plant enclosures. These items may be stored outside of child use areas in metal cabinets or storage facilities accessible only to authorized personnel.

Flammable materials such as plastic buckets and materials were stored in both the furnace rooms.

Technical assistance was provided regarding the following:

1. Incomplete child information cards.
2. Supervision in the infant room.
3. Sippy cups with mail to be labeled.
4. Cabinets in the rooms to be locked.
5. Parental permission for children 2.9 years and older.
6. Staff members to sit with the toddlers during mealtimes.

On 10/18/22, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.
