II. Purpose of Addendum

On 08/17/2022, Robin Pappas requested the following modification to the child care license:

- To license classroom 21.
- To increase the center's total capacity to 204 children 18-months through school-age.

III. Methodology

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of the original license were modified on August 23, 2022, September 3, 2019, and February 6, 2017. The following rooms were measured and approved.

- Room 22 is 28'3 ft. x 10 ft. and 16'6 ft. x 22'7 ft., providing 655 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 18 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 23 is 29'9 ft. x 19'9 ft. and 5.6 ft. x 19'6 ft., providing 695 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 18 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 24 is 27'6 ft. x 16'10 ft. and 19'3 ft. x 6'9 ft., providing 593 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 25 is 29'6 ft. x 17'9 ft. and 6' x 23 ft., providing 662 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 26 is 29 ft. x 17'9 ft. and 6 ft. x 22'9 ft., providing 651 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 27 is 29'6 ft. x 17ft. and 6'6 feet x 19'3 ft., providing 627 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 28 is 29 ft. x 17 ft. and 6'6 ft. x 19'6 ft., providing 620 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 12 children under age 30 months, an

age range which requires 50 square feet of space per child. Depending upon enrollment, this space might be used for 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.

- Room 29 is 28 ft. x 21'9 ft., providing 609 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 12 children under age 30 months, an age range which requires 50 square feet of space per child. Depending upon enrollment, this space might be used for 16 children over age 30 months an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 30 is 23'4 ft. x 28'3 ft., providing 659 square feet, sufficient for the requested capacity of 12 children under age 30 months, an age range which requires 50 square feet of space per child. Depending upon enrollment, this space might be used for 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 30A is 36 ft. x 18 ft. and 8 ft. x 2 ft., providing 664 square feet of space, suitable for the requested capacity of 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 30B is 25 ft. x 10 ft. and 22 ft. x 17 ft., providing 624 square feet of space, suitable for the requested capacity of 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Room 30C is 26 ft. x 16 ft. and 16ft. x 13 ft., providing 624 square feet of space, suitable for the requested capacity of 16 children over age 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child.
- Gross motor room provides a total of 2,084 of square feet of space, suitable for 60 children over age 30 months. This room will not always be in use and was not factored into the licensed capacity. Ms. Pappas is aware of the group size limits for children under 3 years of age.

The following room is now approved for use:

- Room 21 is 32 ft. x 20 ft. and 8ft. x 21 ft., providing 808 square feet of space, suitable for the capacity of 16 children under 30 months, an age range which requires 50 square feet of space per child. Depending upon enrollment, this space might be used for the requested capacity of 16 children over 30 months, an age range which requires 35 square feet of space per child. Ms. Pappas is aware that ratio and group size is determined by the youngest child in the group.

The center is approved for a total capacity of 204 children, age 18-months through school-age. The total room capacity exceeds the requested capacity. Ms. Pappas is aware the center cannot exceed the total capacity of 204 children.

For a capacity of 204 children, the center is required to have 14 toilets and 14 sinks. The center has a total of 14 toilets and 15 sinks.

The location of the sinks and toilets in the center are as follow:

Room 22: 1 toilet and 1 sink
Room 23: 1 toilet and 1 sink
Room 24: 1 toilet and 1 sink
Room 27: 1 toilet and 1 sink
Room 28: 1 toilet and 1 sink
Room 30A: 1 sink
Room 30B: 1 sink
Bathroom shared by 30A and 30B: 4 toilets and 2 sinks
Room 30C: 4 toilets and 3 sinks
Kitchen: 2 sinks
Bathroom next to kitchen: 1 toilet and 1 sink

An environmental health inspection was completed on the new construction on 08/23/2019. A fire inspection was completed on the new construction on 08/20/2019. Environmental health and fire safety inspections were completed on the original building at the time the original license was issued. A lead risk assessment was not required as the original building and the addition were built after 1978.

A playground inspection was completed on 08/27/20019. The playground is enclosed by fencing. The playground surface area consists of unitary poured in material or rubber chips. All the climbing structures and equipment are approved for ages 2-5 years old. The following area have been inspected:

- Log area
- Bikes and water play
- Seesaw
- Painting and storage
- Bridge
- Bench
- Rock wall
- Roofed structures
- Sand box
- Spring rocker
- Rope climber
- Composite climber

The program operates year-round. Half and full-day options are offered to preschool children. The half-day session operates from 9:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. The full-day preschool starts at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. Optional extended care is available from 7:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.

The center does not provide transportation or offer off-site field trips.
Swimming is not offered.

Parents are responsible for providing lunch for their children. This food must follow the Kashrut dietary practices. The preschool will provide snacks.

V. Recommendation

Classroom 21 is approved for use by children under 30-months and over 30-months.

The centers total capacity has been increased to 204 children, 18-months through school-age.
