R400.8125	The staff did not provide appropriate care of Child A. A total of eight different foot art projects were completed with Child A within a timeframe of 15-20 minutes. Each time a process involving multiple steps which included wiping, washing, drying, and re-painting the foot was completed. This process was completed for each project even when other projects used the same color paint and when Child A became fussy.	The staff have all been individually trained on age-appropriate art, timeframe of project and multiple usage to complete a project. No child will complete more than two-foot prints on any given day. If multiple colors are needed for a project, only one color will be used per day.	Staff trained immediately.


R400.8179	The highchair used by the child care staff member was not appropriate to the developmental needs of Child A who is 2 months old and unable to maintain neck and upper body strength without assistance.	All staff have been trained on the use of age-appropriate equipment within the classroom.	Staff trained immediately
R400.8179	The facility completed eight painting projects with Child A who is two months old. These activities were not appropriate to the developmental level of the child.	We will continue doing developmentally age-appropriate activities with the classroom, limiting holiday parent take home projects.	Staff trained immediately

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
