## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8122**

**Lead caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities.**

(7) Lead caregivers for infants and toddlers shall have 3 semester hours, 4.5 CEUs, or 45 hours of MiRegistry approved infant and toddler development and care practices within 6 months of hire. These semester hours or CEUs may satisfy a portion of the requirements of subrule (6) of this rule.

One of toddler lead caregivers did not have 4.5 ceu's or 45 hours of MiRegistry approved infant and toddler development and care practices.

**R 400.8330**

**Food services and nutrition generally.**

(22) Infants or toddlers shall not have bottles, beverage containers, or food in sleeping equipment.

A toddler slept on the cot with a bottle of milk in the toddler 2 A classroom.

Technical assistance was provided regarding the following:

Fitted sheet for the crib in the toddler room.

Children up to 18 months of age are their own schedule.

Step stool in the toddler room.

Torn cushions in the pre-k room.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 01/09/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

#### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
