This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 09/14/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Child care staff member (H.T.) did not complete the recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect training.

H.T. was hired on 07/25/2022. H.T. has not completed the Health and Safety Part I and Part II.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(1) The premises must be maintained in a clean and safe condition and must not pose a threat to health or safety.

In the Infant Classroom, there was a knife located in an unsecured drawer.

The knife was removed during the inspection.

On September 14, 2022, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided for the following:

- R 400.8131 (5) Professional development requirements. *Health and Safety Part I and Part II:* (a) Administration of medication. b) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions. c) Building and physical premises safety. d) Emergency preparedness and response planning. e) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and appropriate disposal of bio-contaminants. f) Precautions in transporting children, if applicable. g) Child development.
- R 400.8525(4) Exits. Please remove the lock on the exit gate on the playground.
- R 400.8525 (6) Exits. Means of egress shall be maintained in an unobstructed, easily traveled condition at all times that the center is in operation. In the Infant Classroom, *please make sure to keep a clear path from the exit door.*
