III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

At the time of the on-site inspection I provided technical assistance regarding the following Child Care Centers Licensing Rules:
 R400.8131(11) Professional development requirements.
 R400.8152(3) Medication; administrative procedures.
 R400.8161(2)(h) Emergency procedures.
 R400.8325(1) Sanitization.
 R400.8335(1) Food services and nutrition; provided by center.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(2) Child care staff members shall have training that includes information about prevention of sudden infant death syndrome and use of safe sleep practices before caring for infants and toddlers.

Staff MM was working in the Wee Care room caring for toddlers and had not been trained in safe sleep.

R 400.8134 Hand washing.

(2) All staff and volunteers shall wash their hands at all of the following times:

(c) Before preparing and serving food and feeding children.

During the on-site inspection I observed a staff did not wash her hands before feeding an infant a bottle.

R 400.8134 Hand washing.

(2) All staff and volunteers shall wash their hands at all of the following times:

(e) After each diapering.

During the on-site inspection I observed a staff change a toddler's diaper. After the diaper change the staff removed the plastic gloves she was wearing, but she did not wash her hands with soap and water, she only used hand sanitizer.

R 400.8134 Hand washing.

(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times:

(b) After toileting or diapering.

During the on-site inspection I observed a staff change toddlers diapers however the staff did not have the toddlers wash their hands after the diapering.

R 400.8350 Toilets; hand washing sinks.

(5) Hand washing sinks must have warm running water not to exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

The temperature of the hand washing sink in the Wee Care room was 134 degrees Fahrenheit and the sink in room 204 was 122 degrees Fahrenheit.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
