Dear Ms. Walker:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 07/29/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8112 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

- (2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:
 - (b) Maintain a copy of the completed and signed form or forms for each individual entered into the child care background check system under the license.

The center did not have a copy of the signed consent and disclosure on file for five staff: Ms. Kristina, Ms. Georgette, Ms. Nadia, Ms. Sultana, and Ms. Ilham.

R 400.8125 Staff; volunteer; requirements.

- (5) A written statement must be signed and dated by staff and volunteers at the time of hiring or before volunteering indicating all of the following information:
 - (a) The individual is aware that abuse and neglect of children is against the law.
 - (b) The individual has been informed of the center's policies on child abuse and neglect.

(c) The individual knows that all staff and volunteers are required by law to immediately report suspected abuse and neglect to children's protective services.

The center did not have signed abuse and neglect forms of file for five staff: Ms. Kristina, Ms. Georgette, Ms. Nadia, Ms. Sultana, and Ms. Ilham.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Ms. Kristina, Ms. Georgette, Ms. Nadia, Ms. Sultana, and Ms. Ilham did not complete the required 2021 Health and Safety refresher.

R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(2) A child care staff member shall give or apply medication, prescription or nonprescription, only with prior written permission from a parent.

The center did not provide written authorization for the infant's diaper creams and ointments.

R 400.8161 Emergency procedures.

(2) The written procedures must include all of the following:
(c) A plan for shelter-in-place.

The center did not have a plan for shelter-in-place.

The center did not have a plan for lockdown.

R 400.8173 Equipment.

- (4) Play equipment, materials, and furniture, must be all of the following:
 - (b) Safe, clean, and in good repair.

The infant classroom has an exposed hole on the back of the cabinet.

R 400.8176 Sleeping equipment.

- (6) Car seats, infant seats, swings, bassinets, and play yards are not approved sleeping equipment.

When the infants fell asleep in the bouncer seats, they were not moved to approved sleeping equipment.

R 400.8188 Sleeping, resting, and supervision.

- (11) Infants and toddlers who fall asleep in a space that is not approved for sleeping shall be moved to approved sleep equipment appropriate for their age and size.

There were three infants sleeping in bouncer seats.

R 400.8330 Food services and nutrition generally.

(23) Children shall not have beverage containers or food while they are walking around or playing.

The children in the GSRP 1 classroom were eating on their cots while playing games.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(4) Floors, interior walls, and ceilings must be kept in sound condition, good repair, and maintained in a clean condition.

The infant, GSRP 1, and GSRP 2 classrooms have stained ceiling tiles.

R 400.8380 Maintenance of premises.

(5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.

The preschool classroom has deteriorating paint on the molding and around the doorframe.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 09/21/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Due to the infant safe sleep violation(s), all of your infant caregivers must take training on infant safe sleep. This must be included in your corrective action plan. In addition, a follow up inspection may be made to check compliance with the infant safe sleep rules.

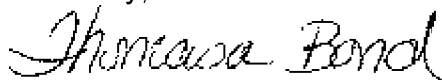
Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
