III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8122	Lead caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities.
	(9) Verification of the education, credentials, and experience of each lead caregiver shall be kept on file at the center or at MiRegistry.
The center did not have verification of experience hours and high school diploma on file for one lead caregiver.	
R 400.8134	Hand washing.
	(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times: (a) Before meals, snacks, or food preparation experiences.
The Infant caregivers did not have the children wash their hands before lunch. REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED LSR dated 11/03/2021 CAP dated 12/15/2021	
R 400.8134	Hand washing.
	(3) Staff and volunteers shall ensure that children wash their hands at all of the following times: (b) After toileting or diapering.
The Infant staff did not wash the children's hands after diapering,	
R 400.8137	Diapering; toileting.
	(1) Except as provided in subrule (2) of this rule, diapering must occur in a designated diapering area that complies with all of the following: (b) Is within close proximity to a sink that is used exclusively for hand washing.
Infant staff washed her hands after diapering in the food prep sink.	
R 400.8161	Emergency procedures.
	(5) A fire drill program, consisting of at least 1 fire drill quarterly, must be established and implemented.

The center did not complete the required fire drills in 2021.	
R 400.8161	Emergency procedures.
	(6) A tornado drill program, consisting of at least 2 tornado drills between the months of March through November, must be established and implemented.
The center did not complete the required tornado drills in 2021.	
R 400.8380	Maintenance of premises.
	(4) Floors, interior walls, and ceilings must be kept in sound condition, good repair, and maintained in a clean condition.
There are stained ceiling tiles in the following classrooms GSRP 2, Infant, and the Infant bathroom. REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED LSR dated 11/03/2021 CAP dated 12/15/2021 Interim dated 08/14/2018 CAP dated 09/05/2018	
R 400.8380	Maintenance of premises.
	(5) There must be no flaking or deteriorating paint on interior and exterior surfaces or on equipment accessible to children.
The storage cabinets in the infant and preschool classrooms have deteriorating paint. REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED LSR dated 11/03/2021 CAP dated 12/15/2021 LSR dated 06/21/2019 CAP dated 07/11/2019 Interim dated 08/14/2018 CAP dated 09/05/2018	
R 400.8750	Motor vehicle operator.
	(2) All of the following documents must be kept on file at the center:

	(a) A copy of each driver's driving record, except for drivers of volunteer motor vehicles, obtained from the secretary of state at least once a year.
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The center did not have the driving record on file for the van driver.
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A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 08/16/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
