## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8305                      Plan review; approval; inspections.**

**(2) An inspection must be conducted by the local health department, and an approval granted indicating compliance**

**with all of the rules in this part, except R 400.8330, 400.8335, and 400.8340, at all of the following times:**

**(c) Every 2 years, at the time of renewal, if the center provides food service where the food is prepared and served on-site, unless the kitchen is currently licensed to provide food service.**

The center provides food service and did not have an inspection conducted by the health department at the time of renewal.

**R 400.8510 Plans and specifications; submission; approval; inspections.**

**(3) A fire safety inspection shall be conducted by the bureau of fire services or a department-approved qualified fire inspector, and an approval granted, before issuance of the original license and every 4 years thereafter, at the time of renewal.**

The center did not have a fire safety inspection conducted at the time of renewal by the department approved qualified fire inspector.

**R 400.8510 Plans and specifications; submission; approval; inspections.**

**(5) Fuel-fired furnaces shall be inspected by a licensed mechanical contractor before issuance of an original license and every 2 years at renewal.**

The center did not have fuel-fired furnaces inspected by a licensed mechanical contractor at renewal.

**(6) Fuel-fired water heaters shall be inspected by a licensed mechanical contractor or a licensed plumbing contractor before issuance of an original license and every 2 years at renewal.**

Fuel-fired water heaters were not inspected by a mechanical contractor at the time of renewal.

**REPEAT VIOLATION ESTABLISHED**

**Corrective action plan dated: 9/21/21**

During my inspection on 4/12/23, I observed the children to be engaged in several developmentally appropriate activities such as pretend play, blocks, arts and crafts. The caregivers were attentive to the needs of the children and displayed positive interaction with them. Technical assistance was provided regarding the following:

1. Refresher course to be completed for 2021.
2. Torn sleep mats to be replaced.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan that includes completion of a fire inspection, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
