Child D	Child D has an assigned spot to sit for all meals. The table and chair are labeled with Child D's picture and food restrictions. The staff that prepares the food will label if the food contains eggs. A food list is posted in the classroom with "yes" and "no" foods for Child D. Staff will contact the office if a food is not on the list. Child D has a personalized weekly menu which indicates which foods Child D can and cannot have each day.	02/06/2023
