

**III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS**

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.8134            Hand washing.**

**(2) All staff and volunteers shall wash their hands at all of the following times:**

**(c) Before preparing and serving food and feeding children.**

Staff did not wash their hands prior to feeding children. A staff member did not wash her hands prior to feeding an infant a bottle.

**R 400.8161            Emergency procedures.**

**(8) Each child care staff member shall be trained at least twice a year on his or her duties and responsibilities for all emergency procedures referenced in subrule (1) of this rule.**

Staff members were not trained on emergency procedures his or her duties and responsibilities during emergencies at least twice a year. Staff were trained once a year on their roles during emergency procedures.

**R 400.8176            Sleeping equipment.**


(8) Swaddling with a sleep sack swaddle attachment or swaddle wrap is allowed only for infants up to 2 months of age. If a child has a health issue or special need that requires the child use a swaddle attachment or swaddle wrap after the child is 2 months of age, documentation from the health provider is required. The documentation must include specific sleeping instructions and time frames for how long the child needs to sleep in this manner, including an end date.

Staff allowed an infant older than 2 months of age to sleep with a sleep sack swaddle attachment.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 02/15/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
