This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 05/02/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the on-site inspection, I reviewed children's records and child care staff members' records. I observed children in care engaged in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities, including reading, outdoor play, gross motor play in the gymnasium, and dramatic play. I observed large group time which included a discussion about plants. I also observed diapering, toileting, hand washing, meal service, and nap time. The child care staff members' interactions with the children were positive and nurturing. They were attentive to the children's needs.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.

One of the five child care staff members was not trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect before caring for children.

Child care staff member M.B. was hired in November 2021 and completed the training on 01/28/2022.

R 400.8131 Professional development requirements.

(4) Before unsupervised contact with children, all child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations.

One of the five child care staff members did not complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations, before unsupervised contact with children.

Child care staff member M.B. was hired in November 2021 and completed the training on 01/27/2022.

R 400.8152 Medication; administrative procedures.

(2) A child care staff member shall give or apply medication, prescription or nonprescription, only with prior written permission from a parent.

In Infant 1 room, there was no written permission from a parent for one child's diaper cream.

In Toddler 1 room, there was no written permission from a parent for two children's diaper creams.

In Toddler 3 room, there was no written permission from a parent for two children's diaper creams.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided for the following:

- Label water bottles with the child's first and last name
- One medication permission form per medication
- Timeframes for completion of MiRegistry Refresher training
- Hand washing after toileting
- Label medication and diaper creams with child's first and last names
- Discovery Preschool room, lower bathroom cabinet hanging off the hinge
- Single service towel to be used when completing 3 step process on diaper changing pad and multi-purpose tables
- Monitor temperature in refrigerators

On 05/03/2023, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.
