III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8128	Staff; volunteer; tuberculosis.
	A center shall keep on file at the center evidence to verify that each child care staff member and each volunteer who has contact with children at least 4 hours per week for more than 2 consecutive weeks is free from communicable tuberculosis (TB). Verification of TB status is required within 1 year before employment or volunteering.
	One unsupervised volunteer and one childcare staff member [REDACTED] did not have verification of TB status on file. Ms. Langolf confirmed they had not completed their TB test at this time. In addition, multiple staff members had TB status on file that was not within 1 year of their time of hire at the child care facility.
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(3) Before caring for children, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall be trained on prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma and child maltreatment, and recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.
	Two of the seven child care staff members were missing the training required by this rule.
R 400.8131	Professional development requirements.
	(4) Before unsupervised contact with children, all child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete prevention and control of infectious disease training, including immunizations.
	Two of the seven child care staff members were missing the training required by this rule.
R 400.8325	Sanitization.
	(1) All tableware, utensils, food contact surfaces, and food service equipment must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each use. Multi-purpose tables must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized before and after they are used for meals or snacks.
	The snack table used by the children was not washed, rinsed and sanitized after each use.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on the following:

- Ensure snack menu reflects snacks being served and update menu when changes to provided snacks have changed R400. 8330(10).
- Maintain accurate written fire and tornado (practice) drill logs R400.8161(7)
- Ensure all required information (special needs, parent location, D.O.B) is completed for child information records R400.8143(1).

-Ensure transferred staff have a signed consent and disclosure form on site
R400.8112(2)(b)

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 01/27/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this childcare center.
