Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the renewal inspection, licensing consultant Chimere Simmons found 3 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. An acceptable written corrective action plan was received on 12/18/2023. A regular license will be issued.

During the onsite inspection, I observed each classroom engaging children in a variety of activities throughout the daily routine. In the infant room, children were sang to and encouraged to problem solve. In the preschool classroom, children were engaged in making a football stadium gingerbread house. In the pre-k classroom, children were engaged and actively participated in circle time, which included letter sound recognition, singing and dancing. The children were served mashed potatoes, meatloaf, mixed vegetables, applesauce and milk for lunch.
