Dear Ms. Hall-Elzy:

This letter is a follow-up to the on-site inspection conducted at your center on 06/08/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

There were violations found during the inspection. The center continues to be on increased monitoring due to the following violations:

R 400.8122 Lead caregiver qualifications; responsibilities.

(5) Lead caregivers shall meet 1 of the following qualifications shown in Table 3.

During my inspection on 6/8/22, there were 5 rooms operating; Infant room 1, Infant room 2, Toddler room, Discovery preschool and Pre-k room. Except the pre-k room, none of the other rooms had a qualified lead caregiver. The program director indicated that the other lead caregivers were enrolled in the CDA program through Key Stone, that offers online courses for the CDA program. The licensee designee will make sure that they provide the proof for the lead's qualifications as and when they are completed.

R 400.8143

Children's records.

(6) Within 30 days of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain keep on file, and make accessible in the center a record of physical evaluation of the child that notes any restrictions and is signed by a physician or the physician's designee... The physical evaluation must be performed within 1 of the following time limits:

(c) For preschoolers within the preceding 12 months.

Out of the 10 children's records reviewed one of the preschoolers did not have an updated physical evaluation on file.


Technical assistance was provided regarding the completion of child information cards in its entirety.

Due to the violations identified, a written corrective action plan is required. The corrective action plan is due 15 days from the date of this letter and must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.
