III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the inspection, the center was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.8122

Lead caregiver; qualifications; responsibilities.

- (1) Lead caregivers are required only for groups of children who are preschool age and younger.

Out of the 5 rooms operating, two classrooms did not have a qualified caregiver.

R 400.8131

Professional development requirements.

- (12) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 month of the notice.

Three lead caregivers did not complete the refresher course of health and safety training on MiRegistry for 2021.

R 400.8131

Professional development requirements.

- (6) All child care staff members who work directly with children shall complete 16 clock hours of professional development annually on topics relevant to job responsibilities that include, but are not limited to, any of the following subjects:

- (a) Child development and learning.
- (b) Health, safety, and nutrition.
- (c) Family and community collaboration.
- (d) Program management.
- (e) Teaching and learning.
- (f) Observation, documentation, and assessment.
- (g) Interactions and guidance.
- (h) Child care center administrative rules.

Two lead caregivers did not complete the professional development training for 2021.

R 400.8161 Emergency procedures.

(7) A written log indicating the date and time of fire and tornado drills must be kept on file at the center.

The center did not maintain a fire and tornado drill logs for 2021 or 2022.

R 400.8330 Food services and nutrition generally.

(19) Formula and milk, including breast milk, left in a bottle or beverage container after a feeding must not be reused.

The milk that was left in the beverage container after feeding was reused in the infant room.

R 400.8335 Food services and nutrition; provided by center.

(11) Prepared bottles and beverage containers of milk and formula must be refrigerated and labeled with the child's first and last name, date, and time of preparation.

The prepared bottles in the infant room were not labeled with first and last names of the children.

R 400.8510 Plans and specifications; submission; approval; inspections.

(5) Fuel-fired furnaces shall be inspected by a licensed mechanical contractor before issuance of an original license and every 2 years at renewal.

The center did not conduct the inspection for a fuel fired furnace at the time of inspection in 2022. The previous inspection was done on 11/6/20.

R 400.8510 Plans and specifications; submission; approval; inspections.

(6) Fuel-fired water heaters shall be inspected by a licensed mechanical contractor or a licensed plumbing contractor before issuance of an original license and every 2 years at renewal.

The center did not conduct the inspection for a fuel fired hot water heater at the time of inspection in 2022. The previous inspection was done on 11/6/20.

Technical assistance was provided regarding the following:

Opened milk cartons to be dated.

All children must wash hands with soap and water instead of baby wipes.

Electrical cords to be contained and not exposed to children.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.

I recommend increased monitoring due to the number and nature of violations.
