On 05/18/2023 staff in the Infant 2 classroom did not provide appropriate care and supervision of Child D when Child D, who is allergic to milk, found and chewed on a cheese cracker in classroom. Child D had an allergic reaction and had to be given Benadryl.	Program director Ms. Junious reviewed classroom policy with all staff. Staff shall serve food during designated times, children shall be seated during all meal times, and staff shall clean up after all meal times.	04/25/2023 to present.

R400.8330(4) Food service and nutrition generally.	On 04/13/2023 staff served Child D, who has egg and dairy allergies, tuna salad made with mayonnaise (eggs). Child D had an allergic reaction and had to be given Benadryl.	The program director updates the allergy lists as needed; the center's menu is modified and some items were removed to support children's allergies and needs; communication with food supplier (US Foods) about substitutions and when ingredients change.	04/25/2023 to present.
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It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
