## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

Each of these child care staff member's first aid and CPR certificates must be valid and retained on file in the center.

	(1) All tableware, utensils, food contact surfaces, and food service equipment must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each use. Multi-purpose tables must be thoroughly washed, rinsed, and sanitized before and after they are used for meals or snacks.
The snack table was not washed, rinsed, and sanitized before or after snack.

	(23) Children shall not have beverage containers or food while they are walking around or playing.

One child was walking around the classroom while eating a cracker.

	(3) Breast milk, formula, milk, other beverages, and food furnished in a same-day supply must be covered and labeled with the child's first and last name and the date.
There were lunches in both classrooms that were not labeled or dated.	
<b>R 400.8380</b>	<b>Maintenance of premises.</b>
	(4) Floors, interior walls, and ceilings must be kept in sound condition, good repair, and maintained in a clean condition.
The toddler classroom has a hole in the wall.	
<b>R 400.8380</b>	<b>Maintenance of premises.</b>
	(7) Light fixtures, vent covers, wall-mounted fans, and similar equipment attached to walls and ceilings must be easily cleanable and maintained in good repair.
The toddler classroom has a stained ceiling tile.

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
