This letter is a follow-up to the Department’s findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your center on 04/14/2021. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Child Care Centers.

During the onsite inspection, I observed five sections of preschool. I observed children engaging in free play, using the bathroom, washing hands, preparing for lunch, eating lunch, engaging in learning, singing activities, and movement activities, and having stories read to them, both by a staff member and electronically. In each classroom, I observed positive interactions between staff members and children. I observed staff engaging with the children, using countdown to a transition, sitting with children while eating, and redirecting children. The children appeared bonded to the staff and were aware of expectations and procedures.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.


