III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I observed arrival, breakfast, free play, and outdoor play. In the infant and toddler rooms I observed feedings, napping, and diapering. All groups were following the required staff to child ratio requirements. Child care staff members interacted with children in a positive and friendly manner. I heard

them use reminders and redirection as positive discipline strategies. Center, staff, and child records were organized and complete.

I provided technical assistance and consultation on the following rules:

- R400.8161 Emergency Procedures; I discussed emergency and crisis management plans with Ms. Kennedy. Written plans and procedures were reviewed.
- R400.8170 Outdoor play area; ensuring natural playground equipment is in compliance with licensing rules.
- R 400.8182(3) (a-e) and (7) Ratio and group size requirements; I discussed with Ms. Kennedy and staff concerning minimum group size requirements for all age groups. And how the youngest child in a group determines the ratio of group size for the group.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend renewal of a regular license for this child care center.
