The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During my on-site inspection I observed arrival, breakfast, free play, and dismissal. Child care staff members provided appropriate care and supervision and maintained staff to child ratio and group size

requirements. Staff interacted with children in a positive and friendly manner. I heard staff use reminders as positive discipline strategies. Center, staff, and child records were complete and made readily available.

R 400.8173(2)	The current list of unsafe children's products that is provided by the department must be conspicuously posted in the center, as required by section 15 of the children's product safety act, 2000 PA 219, MCL 722.1065.
R 400.8134(4)	Guidelines for hand washing must be posted in food preparation areas, in toilet rooms, and by all hand washing sinks.
R 400.8112(2)(d)	Establish and activate an account and accurately enroll each individual listed in subrule (1) of this rule in the child care background check system.

R 400.8143(1)	At the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. The center shall keep it on file and accessible in the center.
R 400.8161(5)	A fire drill program, consisting of at least 1 fire drill quarterly, must be established and implemented.
