The center is completing further training on how to work with children with special needs and will have a second staff member in classrooms when children with special needs requires it. 400.8125(5)(c)	The center did not follow mandated reporter procedure laws and immediately report suspected abuse to children's protective services and only obtain enough information to make a report.	Will follow proper reporting procedures from now on.	Effective immediately.
400.8140(1)	Positive methods of discipline were not being used with Child A.	Will train staff on the most effective discipline techniques for children with various special needs.	Effective immediately.

400.8179(12)	The center was aware of Child A's diagnosis and special needs but did not ensure that a plan was put into place to meet her needs, nor did they ensure the proper training of the staff who worked with her.	Will ensure a plan is made for each child enrolled with special needs which includes input from parents, medical personnel, and other relevant professionals. All staff will be trained on proper techniques for working with each child.	Effective immediately.
400.8380(1)	The hand washing room in the school age classroom was being used for storage. There were toys and equipment strewn about and piled high, filling most of the room. It was not safe for children.	All rooms where children are present will be clean, clear of clutter and safe at all times.	Effective immediately.
