II. Purpose of Addendum

On 05/02/2023 I received a Request for Modification form (CCL-5054) from licensee Angela Loreth requesting approval of two new playground units and a green space on the playground.

III. Methodology

04/27/2023 Document Received; Playground Inspection Certification Summary (BCAL-5047). Inspection completed 04/26/2023.

04/27/2023 Inspection Completed On-Site; visually inspected the playground and installed equipment

05/02/2023 Modification Request Received

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

The terms of this license have been modified on 05/31/2019, 06/16/2020, 06/23/2021, and 05/04/2023.

This child care center is a wood framed one story structure with a full-finished basement. It is located near the intersection of Oak Avenue and School Avenue in Hudsonville.

The main floor and basement of the building will be used for child care.

The rooms on the main floor approved for child care are:

- Room 1 is 30 ft. X 20 ft. providing a total of 600 square feet. This will accommodate 17 children older than 30 months of age. The requested total capacity is 16.
- Room 3 is 32 ft. X 20 ft. providing a total of 640 square feet. This will accommodate the requested total of 12 children younger than 30 months.
- Room 4 is 30 ft. X 20 ft. providing a total of 600 square feet. This will accommodate the requested capacity of 12 children younger than 30 months.
- Room 5 is 29 ft. X 20 ft. providing a total of 580 square feet. This will accommodate the requested capacity of 12 children younger than 30 months.
- Room 6 is 30 ft. X 20 ft. providing a total of 600 square feet. This will accommodate 12 children younger than 30 months.

The rooms on the basement level approved for child care are:

- Preschool 3's room (south) is irregularly shaped is approximately 20 ft. X 37 ft. and 30 ft. X 5.5 ft. providing a total of 905 square feet. This will accommodate 26 children over the age of 30 months.
- Preschool 4's room (north) is and is 20 ft. X 37 ft. providing a total of 740 square feet. This will accommodate 20 children over the age of 30 months.
- School Age room is 32 ft. X 15 ft. providing a total of 480 square feet. This will accommodate the capacity of 14 school aged children.

The total space is sufficient for a total center capacity of 125 children, infant through school aged.

There is a total of 18 sinks and 12 toilet/urinals located throughout the building.

This is more than adequate to support the requested capacity of 125 children.

The rooms are furnished with an adequate number and variety of developmentally appropriate toys, books, art/craft materials and other equipment to accommodate the capacity of the center.

A lead hazard risk assessment was completed on 04/19/2019. An "A" rated environmental health inspection of the lower level of the building was completed on 06/15/2020. An "A" rated fire inspection was completed on 04/11/2022.

The center has two playgrounds approved for use.

- One area includes a small, asphalted surface and part grassy, part pea gravel area located near the front of the building. The area is completely fenced in. At this time, the area does not contain any installed equipment. Only portable equipment will be used.
- The second area is a larger fenced in playground with installed equipment. An inspection approving the playground equipment was completed on 04/26/2023. There is installed equipment on one side of the playground and is approved for children between the ages of 2 years to 5 years and 5 years to 12 years. The other side of the playground is a green space.

The licensee is aware that children can only use age-appropriate equipment.

Terms:

The center is approved for a capacity of 125 children ages birth to 12 years of age.

The center offers full and part time programming year-round.

The center will provide breakfast and snacks. Food provided will be prepacked or ready to serve. Parents will be expected to provide lunch, formula, and baby food for the children as needed.

The program does not offer transportation or swimming.

V. Recommendation

I recommend approval of the newly installed playground equipment.
