

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.


During the on-site inspection, I observed caregivers, parents and children during drop off time upon my arrival, as children were arriving for the afternoon session. I observed caregivers providing direct supervision of children napping during rest time. I observed children and caregivers singing and dancing during literacy and

large circle activities. I observed large gross motor activities during outdoor play time. I observed children engaged in painting and arts and crafts activities. I observed handwashing and snack time. I observed children engaged in free play activities. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and child records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
