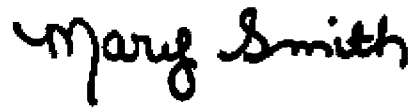

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

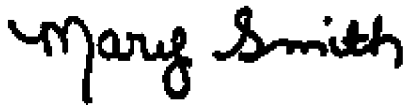
During the on-site inspection, I observed handwashing and snack time upon arrival. I observed children engaged in literacy activities which included reading and storytelling. I observed show and tell time in which children were assigned to bring something from home with a particular letter from the alphabet. I observed large gross motor activities during indoor play activities. I observed children engaged in free play activities. I observed the caregiver, parents and children during parent pick up time. I observed some children playing outside while being supervised by their

parents who had already signed them out of the child care center. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and child records were organized and readily available.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
