

Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.


During the on-site inspection, I observed children arriving to the after-school program with child care staff who walked them from the school to the center that is on the same property. I observed children initiated in show and tell and providing a recap of their day with other students and child care staff. I observed hand washing and snack time. I observed children engaged in free play activities. I observed

children engaged in arts and crafts projects. I observed caregivers, parents, and children during pick up time. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and child records were organized and readily available.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.
