

Approved Child Use Space: Room 209 (Preschool room), has adequate space for 22 children over the age of 2.5 years. Room 215 (Infant room) has space for 14 children under the age of 2.5 years. Room 216 (Toddler room) provides space for 14 children under the age of 2.5 years. The room has a bathroom with an age-appropriate toilet and a handwash sink. The cafeteria is used for the Latchkey program for child use space which is adequate for 17 children over the age of 2.5 years. Room 207 (Multi-purpose room) is approved but not included in center's capacity. Room 213 (Library) is also approved to be used by children's use.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, I observed child care staff members provide direct supervision to children in care during snack time, naptime, diapering, and story time. Child care staff members' interaction with children in care were positive and age-appropriate. The center was clean and safe for child care use. There appeared to be a happy and well-bonded relationship with children in care and child care staff members. Records were readily available and organized.

Technical Assistance: I provided technical assistance on the following:

R400.8134(3)(b): Handwashing: Please ensure that children including infants hands are washed after toileting or diapering to prevent contamination and the spread of disease.

R400.8188(14): Sleeping, resting and supervision: Please ensure there is adequate soft lighting to allow child care staff members to assess children which facilitates supervision of resting or sleeping children.

R400.8335(8)(b): Food services and nutrition; provided by the center: Please ensure milk is served within 7 days of opening to prevent contamination and food-borne illness.

R400.8340(7): Food services and nutrition; provided by parents: Please ensure milk and other beverages must be labeled with the child's first and last name and the date of opening and return to the parent or discard 7 days after opening to assure the health and safety of children.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
