

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed caregivers providing direct supervision of children napping during rest time upon arrival. I observed safe sleep practices being utilized in the infant room. I observed diapering and proper handwashing techniques being utilized. I observed infants during tummy time activities and feeding. I observed one child engaged in coloring activities while other children continued resting. I observed children engaged in free play activities. I observed proper

handwashing before snack time. I observed caregivers, parents, and children during pick up time. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and child records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of regular license to this child care center.
