

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.


During the onsite inspection, I observed direct care staff members providing direct supervision to children in care during naptime and free play activity. I observed children during handwashing and lunchtime. I observed diapering while using the three-step procedure, and proper handwashing techniques being utilized by direct care staff. I observed direct care staff members, parents and children during drop

off time and infants engaged in tummy time. I observed children engaged in arts and crafts and literacy activities. Records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
