

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed children during large circle time upon my arrival. Children were engaged in literacy activities while singing and dancing. I observed hand washing and lunch time. I observed caregivers providing direct supervision of children resting during nap time. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and child records were organized and readily available.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
