III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection there were 26 child care children and five child care staff members. I observed free play, crafts and breakfast. Child care staff members were appropriately engaged with the children throughout the visit.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical assistance was provided for the following:

- Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting R 400.8112(f)
- I provided a sample of an emergency plan.

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
