

Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.


During the onsite inspection, I observed caregivers providing direct supervision to children napping during rest time upon my arrival. I observed children transitioning from rest time to free play time. I observed diapering and proper handwashing techniques being utilized for infants and caregivers. I observed handwashing and snack time. I observed children engaged in free play activities. I observed literacy activities as the program director was reading a book to the children. I observed caregivers, parents and children during pick up time. Caregiver interactions with

children were positive and nurturing. Required records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
