### Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, I observed the child care staff members providing direct supervision of children napping during rest time. I observed children transitioning from rest time to snack time which included using the bathroom and proper handwashing techniques being utilized. I observed hand washing and snack time. I observed children engaged in large circle time which included literacy activities as well as singing and dancing. I observed children being supervised during large gross motor and outdoor play activities. I observed arts and craft activities. I observed the caregivers, parents, and children during pick up time. Caregiver interactions with children were observed to be caring and nurturing. Required records were organized and readily available for review.

R 400.8365(3)	<p>If temperatures exceed 82 degrees Fahrenheit, then a center shall take measures to cool the children.</p> <p>There were several rooms where the temperature was over 85 degrees and despite measures taken to cool the children and child care staff members with ceiling fans the temperature was not coming down. There are two fans installed in each room however it may be wise to purchase some portable air conditioners instead. Several of the child care staff members were observed to be sweating profusely.</p>
