

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed children engaged in free play activities upon my arrival. I observed children playing with age-appropriate toys and practicing imaginary play. I observed large circle time while the caregivers engaged the children in literacy activities including singing and dancing. I observed handwashing before family style lunch. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Required records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
