

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed children initiated in outdoor activities upon arrival. Children were dressed appropriately for the cold weather and were observed enjoying the outdoors. Children were practicing their social development and fine motor skills. I observed free play activities indoors and observed children playing with age-appropriate toys. Children were observed doing homework, drawing, coloring and doing math problems on the chalk board. I observed several children

playing an interactive game of bowling. I observed hand washing and snack time. I also observed parent pick up. Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and child records were organized and readily available.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care center.
