Findings of the Inspection

The renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center [administrative rules](#) and [statutes](#). Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the onsite inspection, I observed the caregivers providing direct supervision to children napping during rest time upon my arrival. I observed several children engaged in quiet activities such as reading and drawing while other children were still resting. I observed hand washing and snack time. I observed children engaged in large circle time which included literacy activities. I observed caregivers and children during outdoor play time which included large gross motor activities such as running and jumping. I observed caregivers, children, and parents during pick up time. Caregiver interactions with children were observed to be positive and nurturing. Required records were organized and readily available for review.


As a result of the renewal inspection(s) on 2/27/2024, licensing consultant Mary Smith did not find any rule or law violations. A regular license will be issued.
