

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children's records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

During the on-site inspection, I observed child care staff members providing direct supervision of infants napping. I observed safe sleep practices being utilized. I observed proper handwashing being utilized during diapering. I observed children engaged in literacy activities. I observed appropriate handwashing techniques being utilized before lunch time. I observed caregivers providing direct supervision of children napping during rest time. I observed children engaged in free play activities. I also observed parents, caregivers, and children during drop off and pick up time.

Caregiver interactions with children were positive and nurturing. Staff and children records were organized and readily available.

Technical Assistance was provided regarding the following rules:

R400.8131(5) – Ensuring that within 90 days of being hired, all child care staff members and unsupervised volunteers who work directly with children shall complete Health and Safety 1 & 2 in MiRegistry. Several child care staff members took the wrong Health and Safety course in MiRegistry and had completed the refresher course instead of Health and Safety 1 & 2, as required.

R400.8143(1) – Ensuring that at the time of a child's initial attendance, a center shall obtain a child information card, using a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute, that is completed and signed by the child's parent. Several child information cards were not complete and had blank spaces. The center will ensure that the child information card is completely filled out before a child's initial attendance to ensure information is correct.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
