To get	The center will train staff when they start employment on how to redirect children in an appropriate manner. The program director will train each staff member on appropriate ways to discipline by showing redirection tools and words for them to use. The center will also be utilizing positive discipline training resources found on MiRegistry.	Immediately

	Child A to stay on his cot, a child care staff member placed her leg over his legs to get him to stop kicking and remain on the cot.		
R 400.8158 (2) (b) Incident, accident, injury, illness, death, fire reporting	An allegation involving inappropriate contact from Child A's Mother was made to the center on 04/04/2022 and was not reported to the department within 24 hours.	The program director or designee will report to the department within 24 hours via phone or email.	Immediately
R 400.8167 (3) Indoor space.	The center office is not approved child use space and should not have been used by Child A.	Only approved spaces will be used in the center. The program director will make sure that any unapproved spaces are not used for children. This will be part of the staff training for new hires. This has also been reviewed with current child care staff members.	Immediately

It is expected that the corrective action plan will be implemented within the time frames as outlined in your plan.

A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.
