| <b>R 400.8330 (13)</b><br><b>Food services and nutrition generally</b> | In the infant room, I observed bottles to be warmed by heating water up in a plastic cup in the microwave. The bottle is then warmed in the cup. The safe and appropriate method for warming bottles is with a bottle warmer. | Bottle warmers are being used and an additional bottle warmer has been purchased. The office staff will ensure bottles are being warmed in this manner. | Immediately          |

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| <b>R 400.8330 (21)</b><br><b>Food services and nutrition generally</b>           | I observed an infant who was feeding to be seated in a bouncy seat and not be held by a child care staff member. The infant was having difficulty holding their bottle and child care staff members had to assist the infant.   | Infants will be held while being fed and compliance will be monitored by office staff.  | Immediately |
| <b>R 400.8335 (5)</b><br><b>Food services and nutrition; provided by center.</b> | The center provides formula for infants that is not commercially prepared. The center has been provided technical assistance on the need for formula to be commercially prepared and ready to feed, which would not include the powder formula observed during the inspection.  | Liquid formula will be provided. The center will only purchase liquid formula to provide to infants.  | Immediately |
| <b>R 400.8340 (3)</b><br><b>Food services and nutrition; provided by parents</b> | I observed four bottles to be labeled with the child's first name only and no date. I also three observed bottles and beverage containers (sippy cups) to be not covered.   | Bottle labels have been printed for each child and will be filled out each morning by the parents.  | Immediately |
| <b>R 400.8380 (1)</b><br><b>Maintenance of premises</b>                          | I observed the following violations with this rule: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A child care staff member in the infant room to be walking in bare feet, without socks or shoes.</li> <li>• In the toddler room, beginning preschool room, and preschool rooms, I observed tubs of bleach on the counter and within reach of the children. The bleach was utilized as the</li> </ul> | All staff have been informed that they must wear socks, slippers, or indoor shoes while in the room. Bleach water buckets have been moved out of the reach of children. | Immediately |
