III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care center administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the center’s records, including staff records and children’s records. Staff records include background checks and training information. Children’s records include child information cards, physical examination dates, and immunizations.

I was unable to observe the outdoor play area due to the large amount of snow. Ms. Murray stated that in the fall, pea pebbles had been added to the play area per Erin Kidd’s recommendation at the time of the previous interim. Also at the time of this renewal inspection one of the GSRP classrooms was not occupied due to low enrollment.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care center.
